

Rehabilitation Work to Ventilation Shaft Lawrence Station

Yonge Street and Bedford Park Avenue

April to Early December 2010

Beginning in April 2010*, the TTC will carry out concrete structural rehabilitation work to the subway ventilation shaft located in the southbound lanes on Yonge Street at Bedford Park Avenue, just north of Lawrence Avenue. This work is scheduled for completion in early December 2010*.

(* Scheduled timelines are subject to change due to unforeseen events)

Work Includes

- Concrete structural repairs to the existing vent shaft. All work conducted at street level will occur within this vent shaft area.
- Reconstruction of concrete slab sections of the vent shaft. The removal of the existing deteriorating slabs will be conducted from street level.
- Concrete re-facing of the vent shaft walls and installation of reinforcing steel.
- New drains associated with the vent shaft.
- New roadway grates and supporting steel beams.
- Concrete repairs to a maintenance room situated north of vent shaft inside the station.

Details

Work at street level will be conducted between the months of April and early December. Work involves some excavation and reconstruction work to the vent shaft.

The vent shaft work area will be secured/sectioned-off in accordance with City of Toronto requirements, resulting in lane restrictions on Yonge Street through the work zone to maintain a safe working area. The traffic restrictions will be in affect for approximately an eight to nine month period.

Note: If required, on April 1, 2011 work on Yonge Street will resume at the vent shaft location and lane restrictions will be imposed in order to complete any outstanding work.

Traffic and Parking Restrictions

While the work at street level will be concentrated in the southbound lanes on Yonge Street just south of Bedford Park Avenue, the work zone will require lane reductions affecting both northbound and southbound traffic. Generally, the lane reductions will begin on the approach to the work zone. As a result, on-street parking within and slightly beyond the work zone will be temporarily displaced. The traffic lanes will be restored in mid December 2010 or possibly sooner for the winter season.

Work Hours

Work will be largely confined to the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 7 p.m. on weekdays. Occasionally, the contractor may need to work later in the day or on weekends. Work in the station and in the vent shafts will require overnight activities.

Access and Transit Service

There will be no impact to the sidewalks during this work. Subway and bus operations at Lawrence Station will not be affected by this work.
